The original manuscript has been lost; extant copies were made during Emmett's lifetime. Compounding the problem are Emmett's own confused accounts of its writing and his tardiness in registering its copyright. The song was a favorite of President Abraham Lincoln; he had it played at some of his political rallies and at the announcement of General Dixie E.

For other uses, see Dixie disambiguation. According to musicologist Hans Nauman, the song presented Dixie's point of view, common to minstrelsy at the time, that slavery was overall a positive institution.
